# THE JAYNE HOUSE

*Philadelphia, Pennsylvania*

*Original architects: Furness, Evans & Company, 1895*

*Restoration and Renovation: 2007–2010*



The original building, designed in 1895 by Furness, Evans & Company, underwent many changes through the years including its transformation into a synagogue. From 2007 to 2010, the building was extensively renovated and restored to its original use as a single-family residence. The most spectacular space is the two-and-a-half-story central hall topped with a leaded-glass skylight.
